PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Hx of respiratory distress with open mouthed breathing last night.
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: T - 100.8 Heart and lungs - unable to auscultate due to
purring RR - 60 MM - pink < 2 SPO2 - 99% room air

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

Right lateral and ventrodorsal views of the thorax totaling 2 images available for review.

BREED

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The chest is expanded. The lungs are deeply inflated with wide lumbodiaphragmatic angles.

A mild generalized bronchial lung pattern is noted.

SEX

There is no evidence of cardiomegaly. No atrial enlargement is seen.

MN

Course and width of the trachea are considered within normal limits.

AGE

There is no abnormal mediastinal widening.

Mild gastric aerophagia is noted.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Mild bronchial lung pattern.
- Mild gastric aerophagia
- Otherwise normal radiographic presentation of the thorax.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The acute respiratory signs are not explained by the relatively normal radiographic presentation of the thorax. There is no radiographic evidence of cardiovascular pathology.

A mild generalized bronchial lung pattern is noted which may be associated with lower airway disease. This, however, should not cause severe respiratory distress. Consider presence of systemic disease, upper airway pathology, or neurologic disease.
