


**PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

Pixie Morriss Yesterday acute onset of vomiting, 5 times in short period of time. No diarrhea. No known ingestion of foreign material. Today no vomiting, eating well. Owner anxious.

**SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN**

Canine Right/left lateral and ventrodorsal views totaling 3 images provided for review.

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

**BREED** The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

Cavalier X No abnormalities of the extra-abdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

**SEX** The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

Neutered Male The liver is appropriate in position and size and presents uniform opacity.

**AGE** The splenic head is in the anticipated position and within normal limits for size and opacity. The splenic body and tail are considered normal for position, size, shape, and opacity.

4 Years Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation, and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

**INTERPRETED BY** A moderate amount of food is seen in the stomach and mixed with a mild amount of gravel. There is no evidence of abnormal dilation of the stomach and no evidence of malpositioning. The small intestinal loops are evenly distributed throughout the mid abdomen. There is no evidence of abnormal dilation, plication or radiopaque foreign material. A moderate amount of inspissated fecal material is seen within the descending colon.
