PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

starting panting one month ago after running /exercise. In last two days started coughing as well, ed fine , no sneezing , no other concern.

SPECIES

Feline

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

Right/left lateral and ventrodorsal views totaling 3 images available for review.

BREED

DSH

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The degree of pulmonary inflation is deep. There is a mild generalized bronchial lung pattern with even distribution and caudodorsal accentuation.

SEX

Male

A thymic remnant is seen in the cranial mediastinum which is considered within normal limits. No evidence of mediastinal lymphadenomegaly is seen.

The radiographic presentation of the cardiac silhouette is within normal limits.

Course and width of the trachea are considered within normal limits.

AGE

6 Months

- Mild bronchial lung pattern.
- Normal radiographic appearance of the cardiac silhouette.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic findings are suggestive for lower airway disease. Consider infectious bronchitis including viral, bacterial, and less likely parasitic or protozoal versus early onset of allergic bronchopneumopathy. Further definition by means of airway sampling would be ideal. If this is not an option in this patient, a clinical trial of treatment for infectious bronchitis versus allergic bronchitis could be considered along with lung worm testing. Congenital abnormality of the heart is always one potential consideration in young patients with exercise intolerance. Coughing does not fit as a clinical presentation of cardiac pathology, however, this should be born in mind since most congenital cardiac defects are radiographically occult and should the exercise intolerance persist beyond the treatment of the lower airway disease, a full cardiac echo should be considered in this patient.
