PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Uncontrolled diabetic (was controlled, but now inappetant etc.
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Pending

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Single right lateral view available for review.

BREED

Poodle

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Mild spondylosis deformans is noted at the lumbosacral junction.

SEX

Female/sp

The abdominal serosal detail appears to be maintained.

The stomach is postprandial.

The intestines present an “elementary” pattern with no evidence of abnormal dilation.

Mild generalized enlargement of the liver is seen.

AGE

14 Years

Part of the kidneys are superimposed onto the gastrointestinal tract. No obvious abnormalities of the kidneys is seen.

The urinary bladder is mildly distended. No evidence of abnormal opacities is present.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Mild generalized hepatomegaly.
- Postprandial gastrointestinal tract.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study reveals mild generalized hepatomegaly only. Age related laxity of the hepatic ligaments may contribute to the impression of mild generalized hepatomegaly. However, diffuse hepatopathy such as endocrine, metabolic, and vacuolar cannot be ruled out entirely. The odds of hepatitis or a diffuse neoplastic infiltrate are thought lower. Correlate with the laboratory values and considered abdominal ultrasound if indicated for further definition.
