RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE STIFLES

Mediolateral views of both stifles and ventrodorsal hip extended view of the pelvis including craniocaudal view of the stifles totaling 3 images available for review.

BREED

Vizsla

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The muscle volume of both hind limbs is adequate and symmetric.

SEX

Male

The radiographic presentation of the stifles is within age related normal limits. There is no evidence of articular swelling, significant osteoarthritic changes, or cranial thrust of the tibia. No evidence of aggressive bone lesions is seen. The subchondral bone surfaces present intact and smooth.

The coxofemoral joints present within age related normal limits as well.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic presentation of both stifles is within age related normal limits. There is no evidence of aggressive bone lesions, degenerative, or other arthropathy that would explain the weakness in the hind end of the patient. The coxofemoral joints present within age related normal limits as well.
