RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Multiple views of the abdomen with approximately 2 hour and 6 hour intervals totaling 9 images available for review.

BREED

Bulldog Mix

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Severe distension of the urinary bladder is seen on the initial study. No evidence of abnormal opacities is noted throughout the urinary bladder.

On the second study, the urinary bladder is still severely distended.

SEX

The third and last study reveals a mildly distended urinary bladder which is seen within its anticipated position.

The gastrointestinal tract is post-prandial and within normal limits.

Moderate lumbosacral spondylosis is seen.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Severe distension of the urinary bladder without evidence of obstructive pathology/radiopaque calculi.

With the severe distension of the urinary bladder and the history of incontinence, urinary bladder dyssynergia / sphincter asynchrony could be a potential explanation rather than ureteral ectopia since ureteral ectopia would not explain the severe distension of the urinary bladder. However, neurologic disease including lumbosacral stenosis and other cannot be ruled out as well and further anatomic definition by means of ultrasound should be considered as well as full urinalysis if not performed already.
