PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Has been off--painful since first of July with some discomfort noted in hind limbs. Has had lyme disease in the past but recent testing was negative recently. Minimal to no response to carprofen as well as doxycycline

SPECIES

Canine

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Ambulatory x 4 with some "goose stepping" noted in hind limb. No neck, nor back pain; no joint effusion nor joint pain noted. Very painful with compression of both femurs R>L with no pain noted with other bone compression. Very painful to extend right hind limb properly.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE PELVIS

Ventrodorsal and lateral views of the pelvis totaling 2 images available for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

SEX

The radiographic presentation of both coxofemoral joints is within normal limits. There is no evidence of dysplasia or osteoarthritis. No evidence of erosive arthropathy or aggressive bone lesions is seen.

The pelvic bones present within normal limits.

AGE

1 Year, 10 Months

The muscle volume of both hind limbs appears to be adequate and symmetric.

Both stifle joints present within the expected limits.

No lumbosacral junction abnormality is noted.

- Normal radiographic presentation of the pelvis, femurs, and stifles.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

No osseous or articular pathology can be identified radiographically in the study of the pelvis and stifles. Panosteitis appears to be a theoretical potential based on the description of the clinical signs of this patient even though the clinical disease typically seizes with reaching skeletal maturity. Soft tissue trauma, inflammation, and musculotendinopathies would be another potential differential diagnosis.
