PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

20 cm x 10cm firm attached on the thoraco-lumbar. The tumor is not ulcerated.
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: glucose hgih, cholesterol, ALT, ALP

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORACOLUMBAR SPINE

Post contrast study available for review. Study is right/left flipped.

BREED

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Limited study owing to presence of motion related and beam hardening streak artifacts.

An esophageal tube monitor is present.

SEX

Female

A soft tissue attenuating ill-defined mass with lobulated appearance is seen dorsal and to the left of the thoracolumbar spine. The mass measures approximately 15 cm in length, 5 cm in height, and 10 cm in width. Spindle shaped extensions are seen in the periphery of the mass within the subcutis. Multiple tumor feeding vessels are noted. The mass is in direct contact with the dorsal spinous processes of the vertebrae T11-L2. No evidence of aggressive osteolytic changes of the underlying vertebrae T10 through L3 are seen. The enhancement pattern appears to be moderate and mostly uniform.

The thoracic and abdominal structures cannot be assessed.

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Large subcutaneous soft tissue mass with signs of aggressive biological behavior dorsal and to the left of the thoracolumbar spine.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Soft tissue sarcoma is considered the primary differential diagnosis in this patient. Further definition by means of sampling could be considered and may aid in the planning of the surgery and safety margins. Completing the staging of the thorax and abdomen may be required.

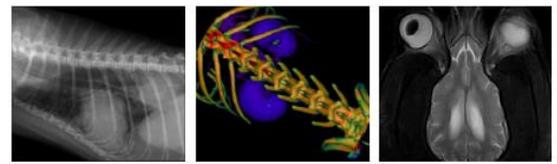



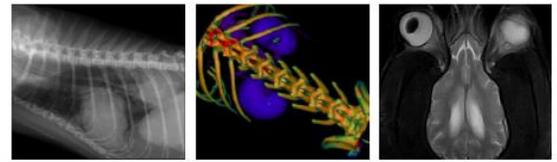
