PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Fell off couch. Lameness on R hind Rule out MPL?

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE STIFLES

Mediolateral views of both stifles and ventrodorsal hip extended view of the pelvis with craniocaudal projection of the stifle joints totaling 3 images available for review.

BREED

Shih Tzu

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

There is no evidence of articular swelling in either of the stifle joints.

The patellae are in situ in the available images in both stifles.

SEX

Female Intact

No evidence of traumatic osseous injury is seen.

The muscle volume of both hind limbs is adequate and symmetric.

The subchondral bone of both stifle joints presents intact and smooth.

AGE

6 Months

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on the radiographic study, no evidence of patella luxation was found. Intermittent grade 1 or 2 luxation is entirely possible and needs to be ruled out based on the clinical palpation. There was no evidence of angular limb deformity of the proximal tibiae which can be one factor predisposing to medial patella luxation in the available radiographs.
