PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Pt presented for intermittent diarrhea and vomiting. Pt had a 4-5 days period where stool firmed up and vomiting stopped, but then started again with diarrhea. Pt indoor only, only pet in the house. No change in diet. Pt not one to get into anything and doesn't get people food. Pt takes 2.5mg prozac SID. BW pending.

SPECIES

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Right lateral and ventrodorsal views of the abdomen totaling 2 images available for review.

BREED

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

There is a sacrocaudal transitional vertebra. The sacrum comprises 2 fused vertebrae only.

SEX

NM

Intervertebral disc mineralization is noted between L4/5.

The stomach contains a mild amount of ingesta and gas. No abnormal dilation, malpositioning, or abnormal content is noted.

AGE

4.5 Years

The small intestine is relatively concentrated in the center of the abdominal cavity with mildly turgid appearance and discrepant gas pattern. There is the subjective impression of a relatively thick small intestinal wall.

The large intestine presents within normal limits.

The kidneys and urinary bladder present within normal limits as well.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Differential diagnosis for the small intestinal maldigestion pattern includes functional ileus, changes of the small intestinal wall architecture, or motility, as well as subileus. Further definition by means of ultrasound is recommended in this patient owing to the discrepant radiographic presentation of the small intestine and patient history in order to rule out small intestinal wall changes, subileus, and abnormal motility.
