PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

acute vomiting and diarrhea for 3 days
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: bloodwork unremarkable

SPECIES

Canine

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Right/left lateral and ventrodorsal views totaling 4 images available for review.

BREED

English Bulldog

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

SEX

Female Spayed

The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

AGE

7 Months

The splenic head is in the anticipated position and within normal limits for size and opacity. The splenic body and tail are considered normal for position, size, shape and opacity.

Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

The stomach and colon contain a moderate amount of gas.

There is severe segmental dilation of the small intestine with fluid, gas, and gravel seen within the mid abdomen. The dilation is segmental. Non-dilated post-stenotic loops are seen.

- Mechanical small intestinal ileus with severe segmental dilation.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic findings are diagnostic for small intestinal ileus. Potential causes include intussusception, nonradiopaque foreign material, and less likely mass lesion as well as extraluminal obstruction. Surgical exploration is recommended.

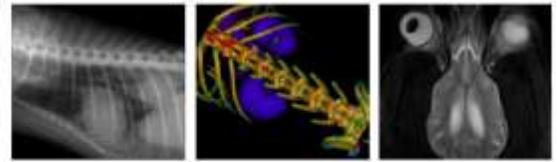


