PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

1yo FS Mixed breed dog (boxer/rottie/lab?) with insidious onset slowly progressive gait abnormality; nonpainful, otherwise healthy, BW wnl. exam consistent with C1-T2 myelopathy (ambulatory with mild tetraparesis and moderate to marked proprioceptive ataxia, non painful. holds her head slightly ventroflexed? but can be manipulated nose to chest laterally and is not reactive to neck extension; delayed hopping in all liimbs, in no other deficits).

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE SPINE

Plain study in soft tissue and bone windows available for review.

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Number, alignment, and general anatomy of the cervical, thoracic, and lumbar vertebrae present within normal limits.

The craniocervical, thoracolumbar, and lumbosacral junctions present within normal limits.

No evidence of discospondylitis, traumatic osseous injury, and no significant disc herniation is seen.

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal CT findings of the cervical, thoracic, and lumbar spine.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The CT study does not reveal structural pathology throughout the cervical, thoracic, or lumbar spine that would explain the patient's clinical signs. Meningitis, meningomyelitis, neurodegenerative disease, and Rottweiler leukoencephalomyelopathy appear to be potential considerations in this patient.
