RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE SHOULDERS & ELBOWS

Mediolateral and craniocaudal views of both elbows and mediolateral views of both shoulders totaling 5 images available for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**Elbows**

Blurring of the cranial contour of the medial coronoid process is seen in both elbows. There is subtrochlear notch sclerosis of the ulnar as well as a large amount of periarticular osteophytes and enthesophytes at the flexor and extensor origins. The subchondral bone of the humeral condyles is flattened and sclerotic.

A soft tissue opaque nodular opacity of 1.0 cm diameter is seen caudoproximal of the right olecranon.

Shoulders

The radiographic presentation of both shoulders is within age related normal limits. There is no evidence of osteochondritis, osteoarthritis, or aggressive bone lesions.

- End stage degenerative joint disease of both elbows secondary to elbow dysplasia in terms of medial coronoid pathology.
- Soft tissue nodule caudoproximal of the right elbow.
- Radiographically normal shoulders.

Hospital**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The patient is suffering from severe chronic osteoarthritic changes of the elbows secondary to medial coronoid pathology. Based on the radiographic appearance, end stage degenerative joint disease with joint cartilage damage very likely and may well correlate with the patient's clinical signs.
