PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Patient presented on Saturday with bleeding and chewing of the tip of the tail, was sent home with an e-collar and antibiotics. O took e-collar off this morning, and left the house leaving patient unattended, P came in for bleeding. Skin on tail is healing fine but blood present on rectal exam.

SPECIES

Canine

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Right/left lateral and ventrodorsal whole body views totaling 3 images available for review.

BREED

Yorkshire Terrier

Abdominal read requested.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Mild right sided and severe left sided coxofemoral joint osteoarthritis is seen.

SEX

Neutered Male

There is moderate gastric aerophagia.

The small intestinal loops present mild generalized dilation with no evidence of plication or radiopaque foreign material.

AGE

8 Years

The colon is mostly empty.

No evidence of a mass effect is seen within the caudal abdomen or pelvic canal.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Gastrointestinal maldigestion pattern with no evidence of ileus or mass effect.
- Severe left sided and mild right sided coxofemoral joint osteoarthritis.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Functional ileus and/or gastroenteropathy are the most common explanations for the radiographic presentation. There is no mass effect visible in the caudal abdomen or pelvic canal. However, the sensitivity of radiographs is limited in this context. Correlation with the rectal palpation recommended. Further definition by means of ultrasound may allow for better assessment of the prostate, lower urinary tract, and large intestine with anatomic restrictions of the pelvic canal, which could be overcome by CT if indicated.
