vomiting 3x per day in the last 3 months. R/O partial obstruction vs gastroenteritis vs others

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Right/left lateral and ventrodorsal views of the abdomen totaling 7 images available for review.

BREED

Great Pyrenees

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The abdominal serosal detail is maintained.

The liver, kidneys, and spleen present within the expected limits.

No abnormalities of the urinary bladder are seen.

SEX

Male Neutered

The abdominal boundaries present within normal limits.

A mild amount of gas is seen within the stomach. There is no evidence of abnormal dilation, malpositioning, or abnormal content.

AGE

2 Years

The small intestinal loops are evenly distributed throughout the mid abdomen with no evidence of abnormal dilation, plication, or radiopaque foreign material.

The cecum contains gas. The colon contains a moderate amount of fecal matter.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

No structural abnormality of the gastrointestinal tract can be identified radiographically. There is no evidence of an obstructive pattern. Functional ileus, however, remains a potential. Further definition by means of abdominal ultrasound could be considered in case of persisting clinical signs.
