PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Diagnostics: Recommended bloodwork: owner declined Three view abdominal radiographs: Radiology review pending Heartworm test: Negative Chance presents today for inappetence, lethargy, scabs and fleas. P has scabs on right paw, right hock and on LPL.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

BREED

Chihuahua Mix

No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

SEX

Male Neutered

The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

The splenic head is in the anticipated position and within normal limits for size and opacity. The splenic body and tail are considered normal for position, size, shape and opacity.

AGE

8 Months

Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

Mild gastric aerophagia is noted.

The small intestinal loops appear to be evenly distributed throughout the mid abdomen with no evidence of abnormal dilation, plication, or radiopaque foreign material.

Prominence of the cecum, ascending, and transverse colon is seen with predominance of gas content. The descending colon contains a moderate amount of fecal matter.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study reveals no signs of mechanical ileus. Functional ileus and subileus remain a potential. Correlation with the clinical findings recommended. Further definition by means of abdominal ultrasound could be considered in case of persisting or deteriorating clinical signs.
