RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE RIGHT TARSUS

Mediolateral and dorsoplantar views of the right tarsus. Dorsoplantar view includes the left tarsus as well.

BREED

Jack Russell

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The tarsal joints present within normal limits. No evidence of articular swelling is seen. There is no evidence of traumatic osseous injury. The tarsal bones are in situ. No evidence of metatarsal and metatarsophalangeal injury is seen.

SEX

Female Spayed

The right stifle is included in the mediolateral view and presents within normal limits.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Radiographically normal right tarsus.

AGE

15 Months

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

No structural cause of the lameness can be identified in the radiographs of the right and left tarsus. There is no evidence of articular or bone injury. No abnormal soft tissue swelling is seen. Consider lameness of other origin including neurologic disease.
