PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

History of coughing/hacking for several months R/O Neoplasia VS Other

SPECIES

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

Right/left lateral and ventrodorsal views totaling 3 images available for review.

BREED

Pomeranian

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The patient is obese.

A nearly mineral opaque subcutaneous nodule is superimposed on prominent skin folds in the dorsal neck.

SEX

MN

Abundance of subcutaneous fat is seen as well as large mediastinal fat deposits.

Congenital vertebral malformation with hemivertebra in the mid thoracic spine and lordosis is noted.

AGE

1/4/2011

The trachea is narrow in general. There appears to be redundancy of the trachea with rightward deviation of the trachea without obvious cranial mediastinal mass effect.

The radiographic presentation of the cardiac silhouette is considered within normal limits.

The lung presents a moderate generalized bronchointerstitial pattern with caudodorsal accentuation.

Moderate gastric aerophagia is noted.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Moderate active bronchointerstitial lung pattern with caudodorsal accentuation.
- No radiographic evidence of cardiovascular pathology.
- Tracheal hypoplasia.
- Aerophagia.
- Subcutaneous nodule in the neck.
- Congenital vertebral malformation and lordosis.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The main finding is the presence of a moderate active generalized lower airway pattern. Consider eosinophilic / allergic bronchopneumopathy versus infectious bronchopneumonia such as viral, bacterial, parasitic, or less likely protozoal. Further definition by means of lower airway endoscopy with airway sampling would be ideal. There is no radiographic evidence of pulmonary mass or pulmonary nodules.
