PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Owner states pet has always had a bow legged front left leg. Last four days he is limping off and on. Owner states he is more stiff when he wakes up from naps. Pet is otherwise acting normal. Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Sent out a CBC, Chemistry, tick fever, valley fever, T4.

SPECIES

Canine

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE CARPI

Mediolateral and craniocaudal views of both carpi totaling 4 images available for review.

BREED

Maltese/Shih Tzu

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Prominence of the soft tissues is noted in both front paws without specific regional soft tissue swelling, and no evidence of articular swelling is noted in the carpal region.

SEX

Neutered Male

Alignment of the carpal bones is considered within normal limits; however, prominent cranial curvature of the radius is noted in both front limbs with shortened and stunted appearance of the long bones and moderate valgus position of both carpi.

AGE

4 Years, 6 Months

The left elbow is included and presents mild osteoarthritic changes as well as blunted cranial and proximal contour of the medial coronoid process.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Chondrodystrophic conformation of the front limbs with bilaterally symmetric moderate radius curvus and carpus valgus.
- Mild left elbow osteoarthritis.

The radiographic study reveals chondrodystrophic conformation of both front limbs with angular limb deformity in terms of moderate bilateral radius curvus and carpus valgus. No additional osseous or articular injury is noted.

The left elbow presents mild osteoarthritic changes. Clinical significance is variable in small breed dogs.
