Normal renal size (left 7.2 cm, right 7.5 cm), echogenic appearance, cortico-medullary differentiation, pelvis, and capsule.

Normal position, echogenic appearance, shape, and size. Left 0.38/0.58 cm, right 0.46 cm.

Spleen

Normal size and echogenic appearance. Smooth homogenous parenchyma, regular curvilinear capsule, and normal vasculature. No evidence of inflammatory, neoplastic, infarction, or infiltrative changes noted.

Normal size, echogenic appearance, portal markings, and regular curvilinear capsule. No nodules or masses evident. Full gall bladder containing normal anechoic bile. Normal thickness and echogenic appearance of the gall bladder wall. Normal bile duct.

Normal appearance of the stomach, duodenum, small intestine, ileo-cecal junction, and colon with no loss of layering, normal wall thickness and peristaltic activity, and no distension of the lumen. Ingesta within the stomach. Fecal material within the colon.

Baxter Wilson Normal size and echogenic appearance, Regular capsule. Normal echogenic appearance of the mesentery and fat surrounding the pancreas.
