History: Excessive salivation, ingested baby Onesie, normal appetite.

ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION OF THE ABDOMEN

Urinary System

Full urinary bladder with a normal thickness and appearance of the wall. Normal anechoic urine with no sediment or uroliths evident.

Normal trigone area, proximal urethra (0.3 cm), and iliac blood vessels.

Normal iliac lymph nodes. Ureters not visualized.

Normal renal size (left kidney 4.7 cm, right 5.3 cm), echogenic appearance, cortico-medullary differentiation, pelvis, and capsule.

Reproductive System

Normal size and appearance of the uterus (0.7 cm) and ovaries (right 0.8 cm).

Adrenal Glands

Normal position, echogenic appearance, shape, and size. Left 0.41 cm, right 0.5 cm

Spleen

Normal size and echogenic appearance. Smooth homogenous parenchyma, regular curvilinear capsule, and normal vasculature. No evidence of inflammatory, neoplastic, infarction, or infiltrative changes noted.

Liver

Normal size, echogenic appearance, portal markings, and regular curvilinear capsule. No nodules or masses evident. Full gall bladder containing normal anechoic bile. Normal thickness and echogenic appearance of the gall bladder wall. Normal bile duct.

Gastrointestinal

Normal appearance of the gastro-esophageal junction, stomach, duodenum small intestine, ileo-cecal junction, and colon with no loss of layering, normal wall thickness (duodenum 0.3 cm) and peristaltic activity, and no distension of the lumen.



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Pancreas

Normal size (1 cm) and echogenic appearance. Normal echogenic appearance of the mesentery and fat surrounding the pancreas.

Free Abdomen

Normal mesenteric lymph nodes (0.3 cm).
No ascites.
