ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION OF THE ABDOMEN

Urinary System

Full urinary bladder with a normal thickness appearance of the wall. Normal anechoic urine with no sediment or uroliths evident.

Normal trigone area, proximal urethra, and iliac blood vessels.

Normal lymph nodes. Ureters not visualized.

Normal renal size (both 6 cm), echogenic appearance, cortico-medullary differentiation, blood flow, pelvis, and capsule.

Reproductive System

Poorly visualized but appears normal.

Adrenal Glands

Normal shape, echogenic appearance, position, and size. Left 3.25 x 0.42/0.44 cm, right 2.42 x 0.47/0.4 cm.

Spleen

Normal size and echogenic appearance. Smooth homogenous parenchyma, regular curvilinear capsule, and normal vasculature. No evidence of inflammatory, neoplastic, infarction, or infiltrative changes noted.

Liver

Normal size, echogenic appearance, prominent portal markings, and regular curvilinear capsule. No nodules or masses evident.

Gall bladder

Full gall bladder containing normal anechoic bile. Normal thickness and appearance of the gall bladder wall. Normal bile duct.



PATIENT ***Gastrointestinal***

Lucky Delaine Normal appearance of the stomach, duodenum, small intestine, ileo-cecal junction, and colon with no loss of layering, normal wall thickness (small intestine 0.24-0.44 cm) and peristalsis, and no distension of the lumen. Ingesta and chyle as well as gas within the stomach and small intestine, respectively.
