Linus White	History: possible pyloric thickening on rads
SPECIES	ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION OF THE ABDOMEN
Canine	Urinary System
BREED	The urinary bladder is full, with a normal thickness and smooth appearance of the wall. Normal anechoic urine with no sediment or uroliths evident.
Dachshund	Normal appearance of the trigone area, proximal urethra, and iliac blood vessels.
SEX	Normal appearance and size of the iliac lymph nodes. Ureters not visualized, which can be considered a normal finding.

AGE	Normal renal size (left kidney 4.50 cm / right kidney 5.10 cm), architecture, echogenic appearance, cortico-medullary differentiation, which maintains a 1:3 cortex to medulla ratio, pelvis, and capsule. No infarcts, mineralization or renoliths evident.

WEIGHT	Reproductive System
16.4 lbs	Small hypoechoic prostate (1.00 cm).
INTERPRETED BY	Adrenal Glands
Remo Lobetti, BVSc, MMedVet (Med), PhD, Dipl. ECVIM	Normal shape, echogenic appearance, size (left 0.56 cm / right 0.55 cm), position, and appearance of the visible peri-renal vasculature.
IMAGING PERFORMED BY	Spleen
Lara Wiseman	Normal size and echogenic appearance. Smooth homogenous parenchyma and regular curvilinear capsule. Normal volume of the splenic vasculature without any overt congestion or thrombosis evident. No inflammatory, neoplastic, infarction, or infiltrative changes evident.
HOSPITAL NAME	Liver
Heron Lakes AH	Normal size, echogenic appearance, portal markings, and regular curvilinear capsule. No nodules or masses evident. Normal appearance of the hepatic and portal vasculature.
REFERRING VET	Gallbladder
Heron Lakes AH	The gallbladder is full, containing normal anechoic bile. Normal thickness and echogenic appearance of the wall. Normal size and appearance of the cystic and common bile duct.
INVOICE	Gastrointestinal
13730	Normal appearance of the stomach (0.30 cm), duodenum (0.30 cm, 0.46 cm), jejunum (0.34 cm), small intestine, ileo-cecal junction, and colon with no loss of layering, 1:3 muscularis to mucosa ratio, normal wall thickness and peristaltic activity, and no distension of the lumen. Small amount of ingesta within the stomach.
DATE	Pancreas
7.19.23	Normal size (right 0.80 cm) and echogenic appearance. Regular capsule. Normal echogenic appearance of the mesentery and fat surrounding the pancreas.
