Jazz Kirks
Breed: Mini Australian Shepard Mix
History: Hx of elevated liver enzymes - ALT, ALP, GGT and BUN elevation. Ultrasound done on 9/2/2021 showed multiple liver masses, splenic mass and small volume ascites

SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

Canine
Surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

BREED There is no evidence cardiovascular disease.

Mini Australian Shepherd
Pulmonary density appears regular without evidence of focal/nodular lesions.

SEX The trachea is unremarkable in diameter and course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth. Carina and the bronchial tree appear normal.

Spayed Female
The mediastinum presents expected soft tissue density, there is no evidence of tracheobronchial, cranial mediastinal or sternal lymphadenopathy. No mediastinal shift is seen.

AGE The esophagus is not visible and considered to be normal.

7 Years 1 Week
The diaphragm is unremarkable, there are no signs of pleural effusion.

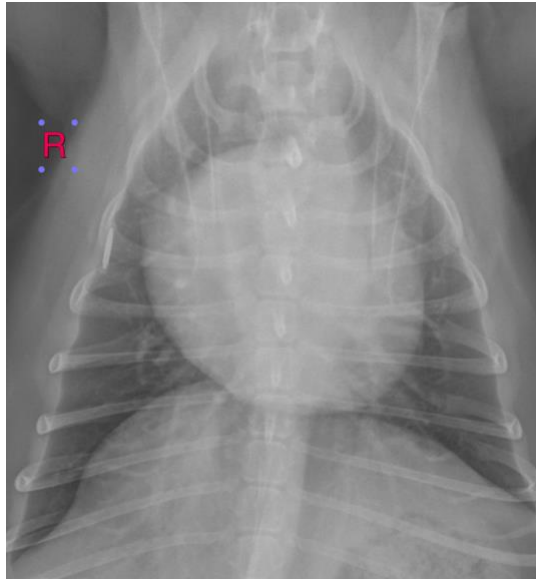
