



## PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

### PATIENT

Lilly Demay

History: Chief Complaint: LIMPING SINCE THIS MORNING History: RAN TOWARDS MOM FOR A TREAT THIS MORNING A MUST HAVE SLIPPED ON THE TILE--SHE LET OUT A SCREECH AND TOOK AN HOUR TO SETTLE DOWN AFTERWARDS. MOM GAVE RIMADYL 25MG AT 9 AM.

### SPECIES

Canine

Both stifles present regular findings without relevant formation of osteophytes. Bony structures are unremarkable without signs of a lytic or sclerotic process. Subchondral surfaces are smooth. Intraarticular fat body is inconspicuous, there is no evidence of a relevant joint effusion. Patella and patellar ligament present as expected. No evidence of a fracture and/or sub-/luxation is recognized. Sesamoid bones are bilaterally unremarkable. Periarticular soft tissues look normal.

## INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

### AGE

8 Years 4 Months

Lesions of the periarticular structures or inflammatory changes of soft tissues cannot be fully excluded as well as lateral compressive lesions of the spinal cord. Secondary lesions or injury of the intraarticular structures (CCL, menisci or other ligaments) are still possible.
