RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE LEFT FRONT LIMB

A mediolateral projection of the front limb is provided for review.

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the left front limb present without abnormalities. The osseous margins of the shoulder, elbow and carpal joint are smooth.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the left front limb presents without abnormalities. Be aware, that rotation of the carpus is limited the diagnostic value due to oblique projection. Rule out pathology of the front paw as source for the clinical signs as well.
