



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Frijole Aguilu Frijole was presented for labored breathing, coughing and wheezing. O noted signs about 3 days ago. Per the O, the Ps clinical signs have progressively worsened over 3 days.
 Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: PE: RESP: Mild diffuse wheezing, no crackles noted, tachypneic with shallow breathing. CV: No murmurs or arrhythmias noted. Offered the O CBC, but the O declined.

SPECIES

Feline

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

BREED

Radiographs of the thorax in three imaging planes are provided for review.

DSH

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

SEX

The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

MN

The heart is of normal size and shape, there is no evidence of cardiac chamber or vascular enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

AGE

9 Months

The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

Generalized moderate peribronchial cuffing is noted with a mild to moderate ground glass-opacification of the lung parenchyma surrounding the bronchia.

The diaphragm is well delineated with even surface and the expected mild cranial bulging of the diaphragmatic cupola.

The broncho-interstitial pattern with the ill-defined bronchial margins and peribronchial interstitial infiltrates is compatible with infectious broncho-pneumonia – such as bacterial, viral, parasitic, protozoal. An allergic origin is possible but considered less likely here.

INVOICE

At this point there is no evidence of alveolar pattern.

Bronchoscopy including BAL can be used as advanced diagnostic test. Empirical management including antimicrobial drugs and deworming is a consideration as well.
