SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Feline
A lateral view of the abdomen is provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The distal diaphysis of one hind limb is misshapen, tapering distally; the ipsilateral patella is displaced proximally and misshapen and the tibia is absent.

Domestic Short Hair
No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

SEX The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

Female Spayed
The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

AGE The stomach is in its anticipated position and is empty.

INTERPRETED BY The small intestinal loops are of even diameter and non-dilated, a small amount of gas is seen within the small intestinal loops and considered within normal limits.

The colon is seen in the expected position and presents with appropriate content.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Empty stomach and small intestinal tract
- History of amputation of the crus one hind limb

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the abdomen presents without abnormalities, explaining the history of vomiting. There is no evidence of radiopaque foreign material or signs for gastrointestinal mechanical obstruction. If clinical signs are refractory to therapy, recommend follow up radiographs (in two orthogonal imaging planes) or a complete abdominal ultrasound examination; in some cases a high ileus may lack classical radiographic signs of mechanical obstruction.
