Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Oral cavity: Mild to moderate dental tartar
Musculoskeletal: BCS = 5/9. Ambulatory x 4. RF: painful at elbow palpation, no obvious bone fracture or open wounds. BLOOD WORK WNL

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the right elbow joint presents without abnormalities.

The left elbow joint presents without abnormalities in the craniocaudal projection.
