RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE LUMBAR SPINE & PELVIS

Radiographs of the lumbar spine/pelvis in three imaging planes are provided for review.

BREED

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the lumbar spine and pelvis are within normal limits.

SEX

Male Neutered

The coxofemoral joints present congruent joint spaces and the subchondral bone has smooth osseous margins.

AGE

7 Years

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal lumbar spine
- Normal pelvis

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the lumbar spine & pelvis presents without abnormalities. Consider empirical management by the means of rest and pain management. If there is strong suspicion for compressive myelopathy and clinical signs deteriorate, cross-sectional imaging is recommended.
