Dog**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the pelvis are within normal limits. Both coxofemoral joints present smooth osseous margins and congruent joint spaces.

Both stifle joints present smooth osseous margins and without evidence of intracapsular soft tissue swelling. The surrounding soft tissue structures of the stifle joints appear normal.
