**RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE NECK**

Radiographs of the neck in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

**BREED**

Shepard Cross

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

Mild amount of mineralized material is visible superimposed on the intervertebral disc space C3/C4. An endotracheal tube is visible in the proximal segment of the trachea. The trachea presents with the expected course and has a normal diameter with smooth margins. The larynx presents without abnormalities.

**SEX**

The pharynx is aerated and unremarkable – but the endotracheal tube.

**RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS**

- Chondroid disc degeneration C3/C4
- Otherwise normal neck

**AGE**

7 Years

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The radiographic study of the neck presents no abnormalities, explaining the history of cough. Rule out pathology in the thoracic cavity as source for the coughing as well.
