Pop and pain on flexion of the left elbow, with decreased range of motion.

**RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE LEFT ELBOW JOINT**

Radiographs of the left elbow joint in two imaging planes are provided for review.

**BREED**

Miniature Poodle

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The osseous margins of the left elbow joint are smooth. The surrounding soft tissue structures are within normal limits.

**SEX**

Neutered Male

- Normal left elbow joint

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The radiographic study of the left elbow joint presents without abnormalities. If there is clinical suspicion for instability, stressed radiographs under general anesthesia might be beneficial. In case of clinical signs for intracapsular swelling, a synovial tap can be used to rule out arthritis.
