PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Seen originally on 10/25/22 for limping. Exam showed swelling below right hock, non weight bearing on right rear leg. Suspected dislocation or fracture. Specialist confirmed fracture and joint subluxation of right rear leg. Owner decided to manager with a cast. Splint changes were performed about 1-2 weeks. Recheck radiographs were taken on 12/29/22. We removed the cast but he was still holding his leg up.

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Attached are the original radiographs from 10/25/22 as well as the recheck radiographs on 12/29/22

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE RIGHT TARSAL JOINT

Radiographs of the right tarsal joint in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The volume of the musculature of the right hind limb is moderately decreased, progressive in comparison to the initial radiographic study.

The osseous structures of the right tarsal joint and metatarsal bones present progressive decreased radiopacity.

The widening of the tarsometatarsal joint is not appreciated in the current set of radiographs and there is mild new bone formation at the dorsal and plantar aspect.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- History of subluxation the right tarsometatarsal joint, treated by cast therapy
- Generalized disuse atrophy osseous structures right tarsal joint and metatarsal bones
- Disuse atrophy musculature right hind limb

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The current radiographic study presents changes consistent with atrophy of the osseous and soft tissue structures due to cast therapy/lameness. No abnormal widening/subluxation of the right tarsometatarsal joint is appreciated in the current set of radiographs, however, check clinically ± stressed radiographs for persistent instability, warranting surgical management.
