



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

CJ Bolger History: started limping 2 days ago, dragging both hindlimbs
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: moderately elevated ALT, rest WNL

SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE PELVIS AND STIFLE JOINTS

Canine
A complete set of radiographs of the pelvis and the stifle joints is provided for review.

BREED RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Shih Tzu An innumerable amount of mineral opaque roundish, variable sized (measuring up to 5 mm), well-defined calculi, is superimposed on the urinary bladder and the prostate.

SEX The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the pelvis are within normal limits. Both coxofemoral joints present smooth osseous margins and congruent joint spaces. The coxofemoral joints are in situ.
Male

AGE Both stifle joint present smooth osseous margins, the patella bilaterally is in situ. The stifle joints present without evidence of intracapsular swelling, but evaluation is limited due to overexposure.

- No evidence of coxofemoral joint luxation bilaterally
- Structural normal pelvis
- Structural normal stifle joints

The radiographic study of the pelvis and the stifle joints presents without abnormalities, explaining the described clinical signs. Rule out underlying myelopathy as potential differential.

There is a high risk for urethral obstruction by the urinary calculi.
