History: panting heavily

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

A left lateral view of the thorax is provided for review.

BREED

English Bulldog

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

There is a significant breed specific barrel conformation of the thorax.

Mild spondylosis formation is noted along the caudal thoracic spine.

SEX

Neutered Male

The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

The heart is of normal size and shape, there is no evidence of cardiac chamber or vascular enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

AGE

9 Years

The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

The bronchial tree presents with thin walls and tapers uniformly towards the periphery as expected.

The lung parenchyma presents the expected architecture and increased opacity due to the thoracic conformation; the intrapulmonary vascular branching is seen up to the third order lung vessels.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study presents no specific abnormality, explaining the panting. The generalized increased radiopacity of the lung parenchyma is considered as sequela to the thoracic conformation rather than 'real' pulmonary pattern. Consider radiographs either in a right lateral projection and/or vd view to rule out pathology of the dependent lung lateral projections.
