Caesar Levitt
Manning History: sudden onset of LFL lameness

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: LFL not ambulating , pain during palpation specially shoulder area , BW reveled hypokalemia , mild hyperglycemia , the rest WNL

SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE SHOULDER JOINT

Canine

Radiographs of the left shoulder joint in a mediolateral and craniocaudal projection are provided for review.

BREED RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Dutch Sheppard

In the mediolateral projection, the left humeral head is superimposing with the sternum and cranial aspect of the thorax. The caudal contour of the subchondral bone of the left humeral head is mildly irregular. Mild osteophyte formation is seen at the caudal aspect of the left humeral head. No abnormalities of the surrounding soft tissue structures are noted.

The radiographic study is suggestive for an OCD lesion of the left humeral head. Unfortunately, the humeral head is superimposed on the sternum and thorax limiting the diagnostic value. To confirm the diagnosis, well positioned follow up radiographs of the left shoulder joint appear beneficial. Consider radiographs of the right shoulder joint as well, as OCD can occur bilaterally.
