PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

History: Patient started vomiting Saturday into Sunday. Started coughing / hacking Sunday into Monday. Not eating/drinking.

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: BW unremarkable

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE NECK, THORAX AND ABDOMEN

Radiographs of the neck, thorax and abdomen in a laterolaterale projection are provided for review.

Pitbull Mix

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Neck

SEX

Spayed Female

The osseous and soft tissue structures of the neck are within normal limits. The most oral aspect of the esophagus contains a small amount of gas accentuating the cranial esophageal sphincter.

Thorax

AGE

11 Years

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

The heart is of normal size and shape, there is no evidence of cardiac chamber or vascular enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

The bronchial tree presents with thin walls and tapers uniformly towards the periphery as expected. The lung parenchyma presents the expected architecture and opacity; the intrapulmonary vascular branching is seen up to the third order lung vessels.

HOSPITAL NAME

The diaphragm is well delineated with even surface and the expected mild cranial bulging of the diaphragmatic cupola.

The vertebral endplates L3/L4 and L7/S1 present mild spondylosis formation.

No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

PATIENT The splenic body and tail are considered normal for position, size, shape and opacity.

Doddle Dakle Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

SPECIES

Canine

The stomach is in its anticipated position and presents normal content.

The small intestinal loops are of even diameter and non-dilated, a small amount of gas is seen within the small intestinal loops and considered within normal limits.

BREED

Pitbull Mix

The colon is seen in the expected position and presents with appropriate content.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

SEX

Spayed Female

- Normal neck
- Normal thorax
- Normal abdomen but spondylosis formation of the lumbar spine

AGE

11 Years

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study presents no clinically relevant abnormality, explaining the clinical signs. There is no evidence of radiopaque foreign material or signs for gastrointestinal mechanical obstruction. The thorax presents without abnormalities, but if there is suspicion for potential aspiration pneumonia, be aware that radiographic changes lack behind clinical signs. Consider empirical management, if clinical signs are refractory to therapy follow up radiographs of the thorax in two imaging planes are recommended
