PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Right Front intermittent lameness. RF had severe cellulitis but resolved. However with long walks, pt starts limping

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE FRONT LIMBS

A complete set of radiographs of the front limbs is provided for review.

BREED

Rottweiler

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Both shoulder joints present smooth osseous margins and the surrounding soft tissue structures are within normal limits.

SEX

The periarticular bones of both elbow joints present moderate osteophyte new bone formation and a tulip shaped conformation of the radial head bilaterally. There is a moderate sclerosis at the base of the medial coronoid process of both elbow joints; the contour of the medial coronoid process is ill-defined/presents a reduced radiopacity.

The pictured parts of the carpal joints are within normal limits.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Coronoid disease elbow joints bilaterally
- Secondary moderate degenerative osteoarthritis of the elbow joints
- Structural normal shoulder joints

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The findings are consistent with bilateral elbow dysplasia due to pathology – such as fragmented coronoid process – of the elbow joints bilaterally with secondary degenerative osteoarthritis of the elbow joints. The finding is a potential explanation for the described clinical signs.

Computed tomography can be considered to check for isolated osseous fragments and decision making if arthroscopy/arthrotomy is an option. Conservative management by the means of pain management when needed and physical therapy are feasible options as well.
