SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Feline A right and left lateral radiograph of the abdomen are provided for review.

BREED RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

DSH The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

SEX The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

Spayed Female The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

AGE The spleen is nont appreciated in the lateral projections.

7 Years Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

The stomach is in its anticipated position and presents normal content.

The small intestinal loops are of even diameter and non-dilated, a small amount of gas is seen within the small intestinal loops and considered within normal limits.

The colon is seen in the expected position and presents with appropriate content.
