PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Acute onset Grade 4 lameness RPL about 3 hours ago when she was running through the woods. Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: She is holding the leg very high off of the floor and acts moderately painful wherever she is touched (even on the contralateral limb). There is mild to moderate cellulitis in the calcaneal area but no other abnormalities are noted. The Achilles tendon palpates wnl and no more painful than anywhere else she is palpated. No drawer sign, increased internal rotation of the tibia, or tibial thrust noted. No decreased ROM, effusion, or crepitus noted any joint.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE PELVIS AND RIGHT HIND LIMB

Radiographs of the pelvis and right hind limb in two orthogonal imaging are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

SEX

The pictured parts of the lumbar spine are within normal limits.

The osseous and soft tissue structures of the pelvis, including the coxofemoral joints, are within normal limits.

The right stifle joint presents smooth osseous margins and the expected volume and opacity of the associated soft tissue structures.

A moderate homogenous soft tissue swelling is seen dorsal and proximal to the tuber calcanei.

The osseous structures of the right tarsal joint are within normal limits, no signs for articular swelling.

The osseous and soft tissue structures of the right hind paw are within normal limits.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The findings fit the history of focal swelling due to cellulitis level with the right calcaneus – ultrasound can be used to rule out bursitis of the calcaneal bursa and check the integrity of the calcaneal tendon. If the swelling can be rule out as cause for the lameness, the presumptive diagnosis is contusion/distortion. Consider a clinical trial with NSAIDs and rest.
