Halo Chabot
 Non-weight bearing Left Hind Limb.
 Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Left Patellar instability.

SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE PELVIS AND STIFLE JOINTS

Canine
 Radiographs of the pelvis in a ventrodorsal projection and the stifle joints in a mediolateral and craniocaudal view are provided for review.

BREED RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Maltese
 The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the pelvis are within normal limits.

SEX

Female
 The patella of the left stifle joint is dynamically superimposed on the left medial femoral condyle. The periarticular bones of the left stifle joint present mild osteophyte new bone formation. There is evidence of intracapsular swelling of the left stifle joint.

AGE

10 Years
 The right stifle joint is within normal limits.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Left sided medial patellar luxation
- Mild degenerative osteoarthritis of the left stifle joint
- Suspect articular swelling left stifle joint
- Normal coxofemoral joints

The radiographic study is compatible with left sided medial patellar luxation which can be a cause for the lameness, however due to the age of the patient rule out failure of the cranial cruciate ligament ± meniscal disease by a positive drawer sign / tibial compression test. If there was an acute onset of clinical signs contusion or distortion might be differentials as well.
