Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Hydration: Appropriately hydrated Mentation: BAR EENT: No nasal discharge; clear no discharge OU; very mild brown debris AU; No cough on tracheal palpation. Oral Cavity: mild dental tartar present Lymph Nodes: Symmetrical, no changes in size, shape, consistency Skin: Good hair coat, no signs of ectoparasites. Entire ventrum, medial thighs, and medial LH paw has mod to severe erythema, mild lichenification around ventral abdomen, and mild crusting. CV/Respiratory: No murmur or crackles/wheezing auscultated. Synchronous pulses, normal rate. Normal bronchovesicular sounds. Abd/GI: Soft non painful abdomen, no organomegaly, no abnormalities on abdominal palpation Uro/Perineum: N Musculoskeletal: P ambulatory x4 when coming into hospital, then jumped off of exam table. Ambulatory x3, holding up LH. Very mild laxity in L stifle. No pain when manipulating joints in LH. BCS 6/9 Neurological: Appropriate

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Both stifle joints present smooth margins of the periarticular bones and without signs of intracapsular soft tissue swelling. The patella is bilaterally in situ.
