A ventrodorsal view and faux profile of the right hemipelvis are provided for review.

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The growth plates are age related open. No abnormalities of the osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures – including the coxofemoral joints – are appreciated.

- Normal pelvis, including coxofemoral joints

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS****AGE**

5 Months

The radiographic study of the pelvis presents without evidence of fractures or lysis of the growth plates. The presumptive diagnosis is contusion. If there is suspicion for trauma of the physis of the femoral head, distracted radiographs of the coxofemoral joints can be used to rule in/out fracture within the physis completely.
