PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

P having jaw/mouth pain ~ 2mo. Trouble eating sometimes and will yelp, most recently when picking up a ball. Two dental cleanings done in the past ~1 1/2 yrs w/extractions. Currently has mild dental tartar w/no other noted abnormalities seen on oral exam. No pain on manipulation of neck.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE NECK

Radiographs of the neck in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

BREED

Beagle

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The surrounding bony structures of the neck are within normal limits. The intervertebral disc spaces of the cervical spine have an even width.

SEX

SF

The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal neck/cervical spine

AGE

6 Years

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the neck presents no abnormalities, explaining the described clinical signs. Cross-sectional imaging of the spine can be used as advanced imaging modality in case of strong suspicion for underlying compressive myelopathy.
