RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

Radiographs of the thorax in three imaging planes are provided for review. Images are provided in JPEG file format.

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

The heart is of normal size and shape, there is no evidence of cardiac chamber or vascular enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

SEX

The cranial mediastinum presents the expected soft tissue opacity. The mediastinal width is less than twice the width of the vertebral column at the same level.

The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

AGE

5 Years

Multifocal mild peribronchial cuffing is noted. The lung parenchyma presents generalized ground glass opacity, partially effacing the pulmonary vasculature

The diaphragm is well delineated with even surface and the expected mild cranial bulging of the diaphragmatic cupola.

Animal Hospital**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The broncho-interstitial lung pattern is suggestive for broncho-pneumonitis, primary inflammatory non-infectious causes – such as lymphocytic plasmocytic, eosinophilic, mixed – and infectious causes (e.g. viral, bacterial, parasitic) need to be considered. The acute onset of clinical signs, is increasing the odds for infectious origin of bronchitis – such as canine inflammatory respiratory disease complex (CIRD). Consider empirical management, lower airway sampling can be considered as advanced diagnostic tool as well.
