RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE PELVIS

Radiographs of the pelvis in two imaging planes are provided for review. Radiographs are provided in JPEG file format.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The osseous structures of the pelvis are within normal limits. There are small irregular mineralization of the subcutaneous tissue lateral to the right gluteal musculature. The subchondral bone of the coxofemoral joint presents smooth osseous margins. The joint space of both coxofemoral joints is congruent.

AGE

4 Years

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Small subcutaneous dystrophic mineralization lateral to right gluteal region – incidental, possibly due to preceding trauma or inflammation
- Normal pelvis & coxofemoral joints

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

There are no radiographic abnormalities of the pelvis, explaining the described clinical signs. Rule out pain originating from the lumbar spine/lumbosacral junction as negative radiographs do not rule out potential compressive myelopathy/degenerative lumbosacral stenosis.
