Limping

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE FRONT LIMBS

A complete set of radiographs of the front limbs is provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Both shoulder joints present smooth osseous margins and no abnormalities of the surrounding soft tissue structures are appreciated.

BREED

GSD

The elbow joints present bilaterally smooth osseous margins, and no abnormalities of the surrounding soft tissue structures are appreciated. The contour of the medial coronoid process of both elbow joints has a homogeneous density.

SEX

Neutered Male

The carpal joints present without abnormalities of the osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures.
