RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE LEFT ELBOW JOINT

A mediolateral projection of the left elbow joint is provided for review.

BREED

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The periarticular bones of the left elbow joint are smooth. The contour of the medial coronoid process presents a mild ill-defined tip.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Mild blurred cranial tip of medial coronoid process

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the left elbow joint presents without overt pathological changes. The mild blurred tip of the medial coronoid process might be caused by more rounded conformation. However, if there is strong suspicion of disease of the left medial coronoid process of the elbow joint, complementing workup by a CT study appears beneficial. Rule out pain originating from the shoulder joint or distal aspect of the left front limb as well.
