**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The left femoral head is separated from the femoral neck and there is mild osseous remodeling at the left femoral head. No additional abnormalities are appreciated.

- Chronic left sided femoral head fracture

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The radiographic study is consistent with left sided femoral head fracture – underlying slipped capital femoral epiphysis is a potential. Femoral head ostectomy is the therapy of choice.
